After teaching sociology for four years at Lehigh University, Mary made the decision to return to Maryland to work and volunteer in government agencies like the Housing Authority of Baltimore City, and non-profit organizations like the Village Learning Place, and North East Development Alliance (NEDA). In 2005, she served as a construction caption and later a board member for Our Playground at Stadium Place.

Today, at an local urban environmental and recreation organization, Mary oversees community greening efforts and programs that educate children, and trains and employs youth and adults in green careers. In this work, Mary combines her commitment to social justice with her skills at engaging our community, enabling her to help make effective strides in creating a healthier, safer, and more sustainable Baltimore.
